July 19th – 25th, 2020

Arrival and Departure Information

Registration is from 6:00-7:00 PM at the Recreation Center on Sunday, July 19th. **PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY.** Campers should be picked up at 9:00 AM on Saturday, July 25th at the Recreation Center (*TCL Staff see bottom of page 2). **Names of those authorized to pick up campers need to be on file at the office. Photo ID is required to pick up your camper.**

Opening Night

The main program will begin at 7:15PM after the registration process is complete. We will not be serving a meal on opening night, so be sure that your child eats dinner before coming to registration on Sunday night.

Payment Information

Balance of the camp registration fee is due no later than July 13th. (Arrangements can be made in advance with the office to automatically charge a VISA/MasterCard for the remaining balance.) The \$40 deposit is non-refundable upon cancellation of your camp reservation.

Mandatory Lice Check

Upon registration check-in every camper must report for a mandatory head check. Do not come to registration on Sunday evening with cornrows, braids or wet hair. Please check your child for lice and/or nits a few days prior to camp, any camper found with lice and/or nits will not be registered for camp and will be sent home immediately.

What to Bring to Camp

- Bible, notebook, and pencil/pen
- Flashlight
- Modest swimsuit, sunscreen
- Active wear for a week
- Soap, towels, washcloth, toiletries, etc.
- Clothes for evening activities
- Spending money for camp store and crafts
- Athletic shoes (2 pairs)
- Water shoes/sandals
- Warm coat
- Sleeping bag & pillow

*** Modest clothing is required at all times. Two-piece swimsuits need to be covered by a tank top or shirt.

Please label all belongings (EFC will not be responsible for lost items). **DO NOT BRING** valuables like cell phones & iPods/MP3 players or radios (*These items must remain locked in your car if brought with you to camp*). In addition, do not bring weapons, fireworks, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, questionable printed material or videos.

Medications

Prescription medication must be in its original container with an accurate pharmacy label indicating camper's name, medical provider, dose and timing. Be sure to bring any inhalers or epi pens needed for your camper.
