Arrival and Departure Information

Registration is from 6:00-7:00 PM at the Recreation Center on Sunday, July 26th. **PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY.** Campers should be picked up at 9:00am on Saturday, August 1st at the Recreation Center. **Names of those authorized to pick up campers need to be on file at the office. Photo ID is required to pick up your camper.**

Payment Information

Balance of the camp registration fee is due no later than July 20th. (Arrangements can be made in advance with the office to automatically charge a VISA/MasterCard for the remaining balance.) The \$40 deposit is non-refundable upon cancellation of your camp reservation.

Mandatory Lice Check

Upon registration check-in every camper must report for a mandatory head check. Do not come to registration on Sunday evening with cornrows, braids or wet hair. Please check your child for lice and/or nits a few days prior to camp, any camper found with lice and/or nits will not be registered for camp and will be sent home immediately.

Dress Code

We ask both campers and staff to dress modestly and anyone wearing revealing, see-through or skin-tight clothing will discreetly be asked to change. Use the following to help you pack clothing that adheres to the dress code.

- **Swimsuit** - Bring a one-piece or a two-piece with a dark t-shirt to wear over it while swimming
- **Shirts** - Shouldn't show cleavage and should be long enough to cover midriff
- **Tank Tops** - Tank top cut must cover bra and bra straps (no spaghetti strap tank tops)
- **Shorts** - Avoid short shorts. Shorts should be of a modest length.

What to Bring to Camp

Bible, notebook, and pencil/pen	Spending money for camp store and crafts
Flashlight	Athletic shoes (2 pairs)
Modest swimsuit, sunscreen	Water shoes/sandals
Underclothes and play clothes for a week	Warm coat for evening activities
Soap, towels, washcloth, toiletries, etc.	Sleeping bag & pillow
Feminine products (even if you don't expect to need them).	An outfit for the banquet night (optional)

Please label all belongings (EFC will not be responsible for lost items). **DO NOT BRING** valuables like cell phones, iPods/MP3 players or radios. In addition, do not bring weapons, fireworks, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, questionable printed material or videos. All such banned personal electronic devices will be collected at the beginning of the week and locked in the camp office for safe keeping until pick up day.

Medications

Prescription medication must be in its original container with an accurate pharmacy label indicating camper's name, medical provider, dose and timing. Be sure to bring any inhalers or epi pens needed for your camper.
