## Arrival and Departure Information

Registration is from 6:00-7:00 PM on Sunday, August 7<sup>th</sup>. **PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY.** Be sure to feed your camper dinner prior to their arrival. Campers should be picked up at 9:00am on Saturday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. **Names of those authorized to pick up campers need to be on file at the office. Photo ID is required to pick up your camper.**

## Payment Information

Balance of the camp registration fee is due no later than July 22<sup>nd</sup>. (Arrangements can be made in advance with the office to automatically charge a VISA/MasterCard for the remaining balance.) The \$40 deposit is non-refundable upon cancellation of your camp reservation.

## What to Bring to Camp

*\*\*\* Modest clothing is required at all times. Two-piece swimsuits need to be covered by a tank top or shirt.*

Please label all belongings (EFC will not be responsible for lost items). **DO NOT BRING** valuables like cell phones, iPods/MP3 players or radios. In addition, do not bring weapons, fireworks, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, questionable printed material or videos. All such banned personal electronic devices will be collected at the beginning of the week and locked in the camp office for safe keeping until pick up day.

## Medications

Prescription medication must be in its original container with an accurate pharmacy label indicating camper's name, medical provider, dose and timing. Be sure to bring any inhalers or epi pens needed for your camper.

## Lice and Nits Policy and Procedures

Upon registration check-in every camper must report for a mandatory head check. Do not come to registration on Sunday evening with cornrows, braids or wet hair. Please check your child for lice and/or nits a few days prior to camp, any camper found with lice and/or nits will not be registered for camp and will be sent home immediately.

## Visitors

Due to safety precautions this summer, we will not be allowing visitors to tour camp during the week of camp or at opening/closing. If an emergency arises that requires you to see your camper, please call ahead to speak with EFC's Program Director and/or your child's weekly director and we will do our best to accommodate.

## Telephone Calls

Please limit calls to emergencies only. If an emergency requires you to contact your camper, call the camp office at 503-630-4978. Office hours are 8 AM – 5 PM Monday – Friday.
