Arrival and Departure Information

Drop-Off is at 6:00 pm at the lodge on Sunday, March 20th. **PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY.** Campers should be picked up at 11:00 am in the plaza on Wednesday, March 23rd. **Names of those authorized to pick up campers need to be on file at the office. Photo ID is required to pick up your camper.**
