Arrival and Departure Information

Registration is from 6:00-7:00 PM at the Lodge on Friday, Jan 2nd. PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY. Campers should be picked up at 7 pm on Sunday, January 4th at the Lodge. **Names of those authorized to pick up campers need to be on file at the office. Photo ID is required to pick up your camper.**

Opening Night

The main program will begin at 7:30 pm after the registration process is complete. We will not be serving a meal on opening night, so be sure that your child eats dinner before coming to registration on Friday night.

What to Bring to Camp

- Bible, notebook, and pencil/pen
- Flashlight
- Active wear for a weekend
- Soap, towels, washcloth, toiletries, etc.
- Clothes for evening activities
- Athletic shoes (2 pairs)
- Sleeping bag & pillow
- Warm coat

Please label all belongings (EFC will not be responsible for lost items). **DO NOT BRING** valuables like cell phones, iPods/MP3 players or radios. In addition, do not bring glass water bottles, weapons, fireworks, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, questionable printed material or videos, or anything with nuts in it. All such banned personal electronic devices will be collected at the beginning of the week and locked in the camp office for until pick up day.

Medications

Prescription medication must be in its original container with an accurate pharmacy label indicating camper's name, medical provider, dose and timing. Be sure to bring any inhalers or epi pens needed for your camper.
